**Translation**: Weekly assignments will be given from *Winnie ille Pu* or *Fairy Tales in Latin*. These will be graded by completion.

**Biblical Latin in Two Minutes a Day**: Students will keep up with BLITMAD and report this as a reading report at the end of the year. In each class, we will have a discussion on the readings.
